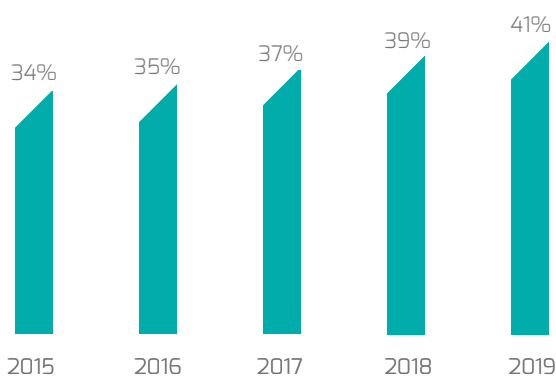

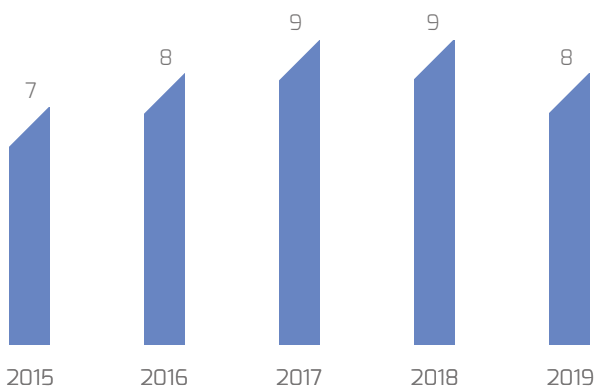
Examples of Actions with leadership positions

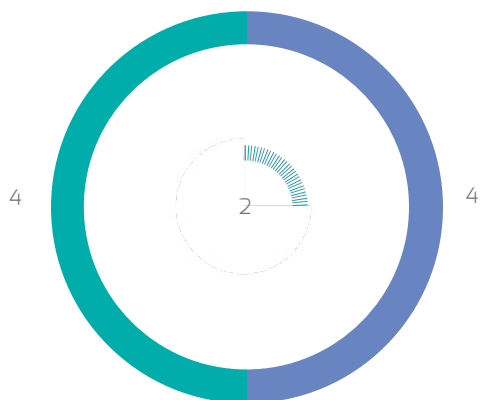

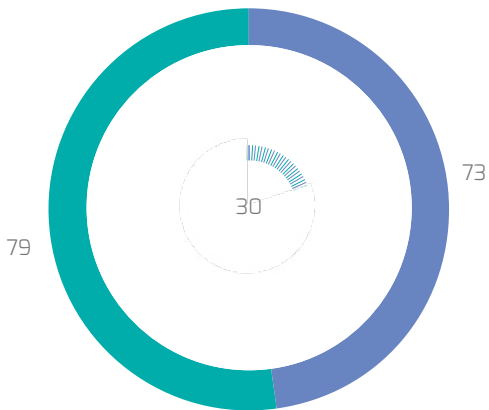

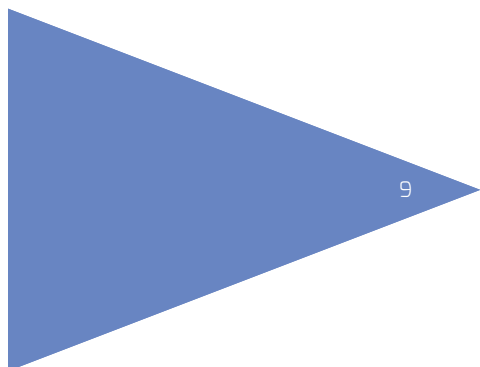


PARTICIPATION IN NETWORKING ACTIVITIES
