



Science Communication Masterclass: Exploring Tools and Methods of Knowledge Mobilisation and Engagement

In its different forms, science communication and knowledge mobilisation are essential to building bridges between communities and amplifying the impact of science, scholarship, and innovation. This international masterclass focuses on approaches for knowledge exchange and communication between researchers and practitioners across sectors and fields. The masterclass will introduce new methods and approaches on how to increase the value and use of science communication for end-users and stakeholders. In addition, the masterclass will provide a valuable forum for participants to discuss drivers and enablers of science communication practices and activities, and how to engage practitioners and scholars of science communication to interact and collaborate.

Participants with different disciplinary and professional backgrounds will be given the opportunity to share their experiences in an interactive way. The masterclass aims to integrate a mix of researchers and professionals.

Main topics cover:

- o Knowledge Exchange and Translation (KTE) tools and methods in practice
- o Type of science communication (research-based vs practice-based knowledge)
- o Practical activities and methods to engage stakeholders
- o Knowledge brokering and intermediaries
- o Concepts and practical methods to support knowledge uptake
- o Methods to measure the impact of science communication

Inspiration for the discussions at the masterclass will be provided by the moderators: **Ulrik Gensby**, PhD and Partner at Team Working Life, Denmark and Adjunct Scientist, Institute for Work and Health, Canada, and **Prof. David Budtz Pedersen**, Department of Communication and Psychology at Aalborg University and Knowledge Broker for Algorithms, Data and Democracy (ADD).
