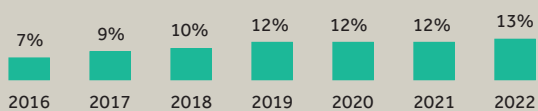

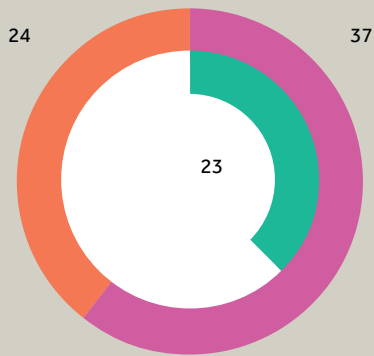

COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS



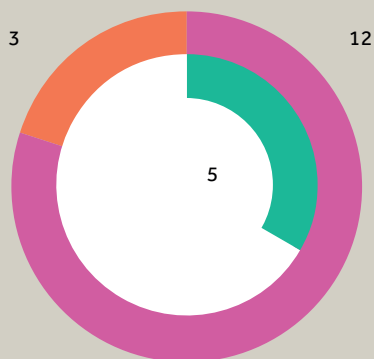

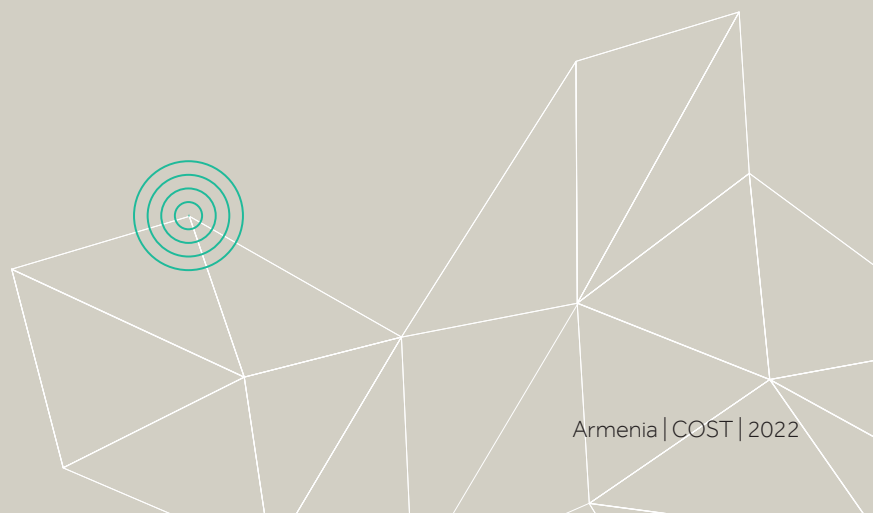
