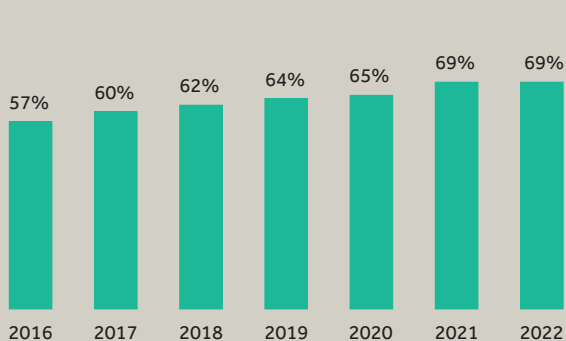

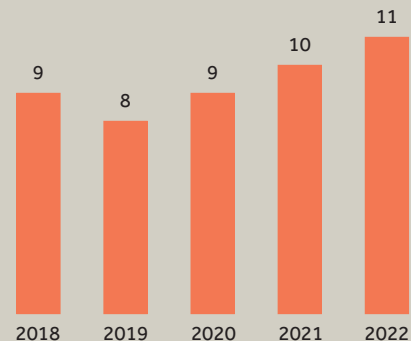

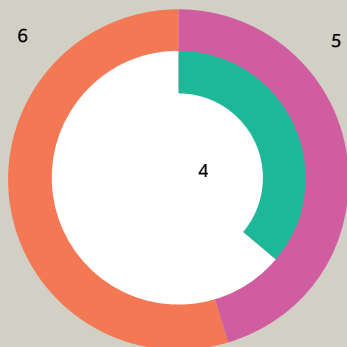


## LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS



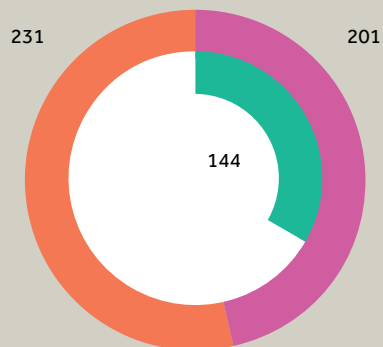

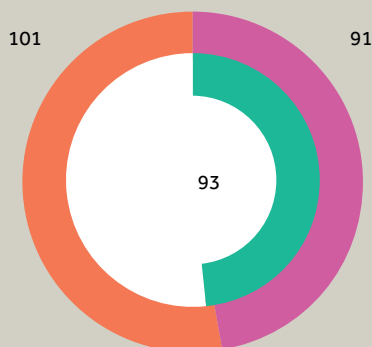
