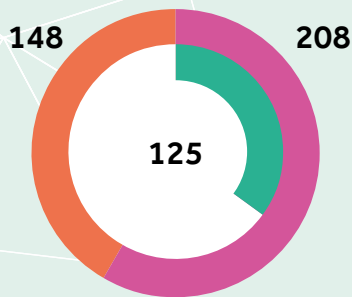

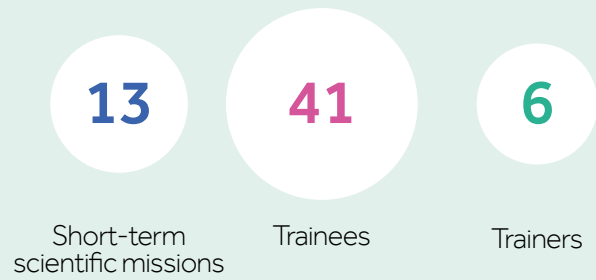

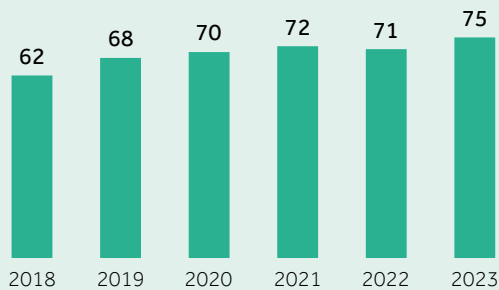
## PARTICIPATION IN NETWORKING ACTIVITIES



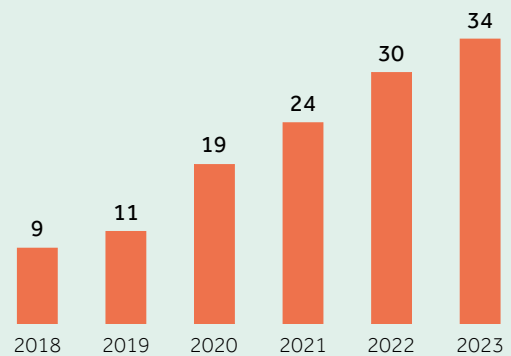
## NETWORKING ACTIVITIES IN LITHUANIA



## COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS (%)

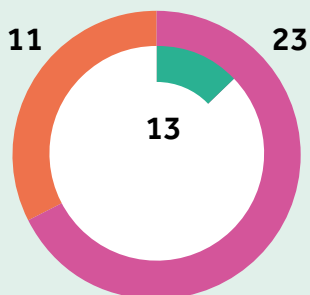


## LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS
