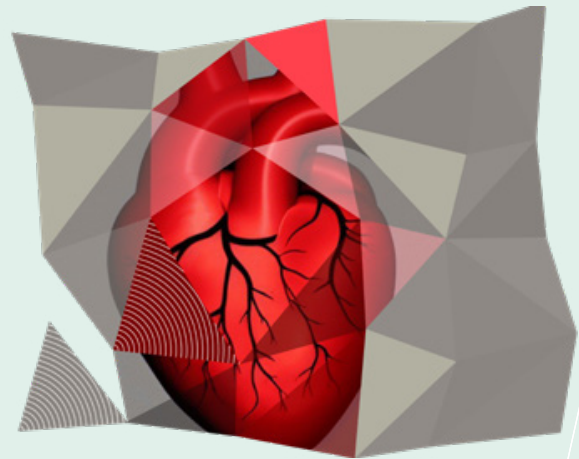

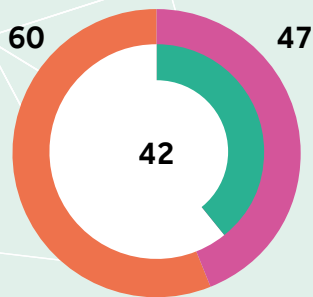

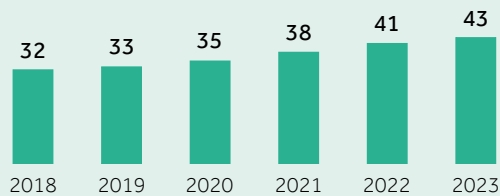
## PARTICIPATION IN NETWORKING ACTIVITIES



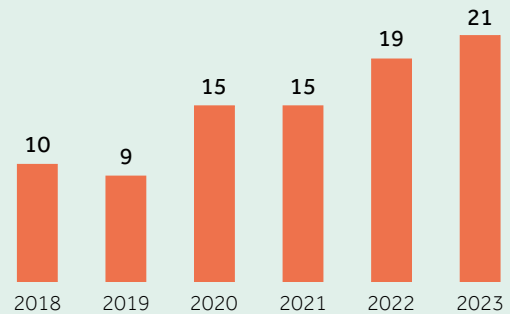
## NETWORKING ACTIVITIES IN LUXEMBOURG



## COUNTRY REPRESENTATION IN COST ACTIONS (%)

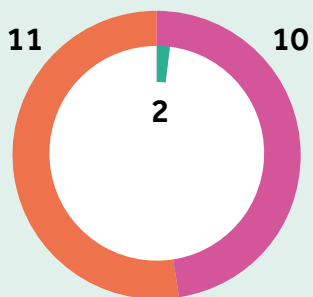
