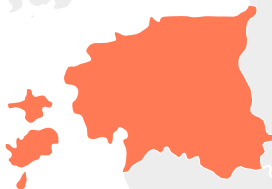

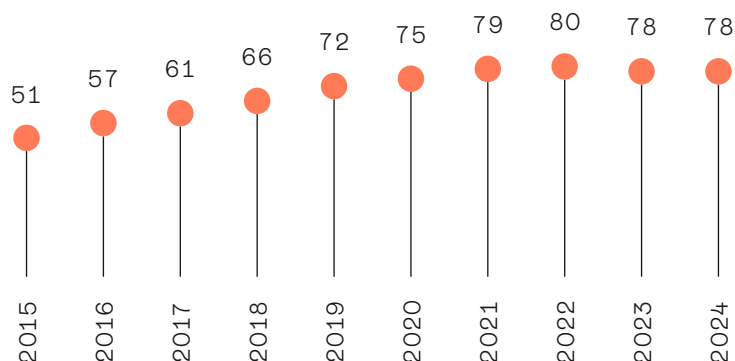

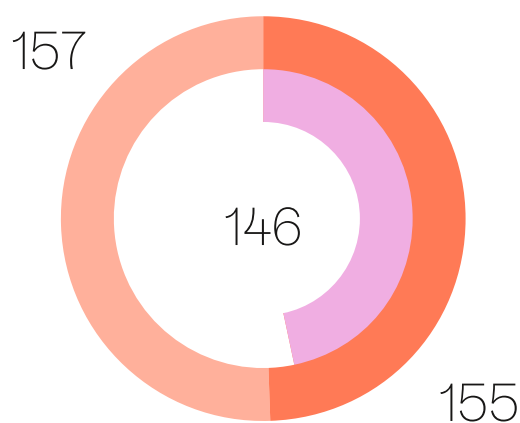
COUNTRY REPRESENTATION

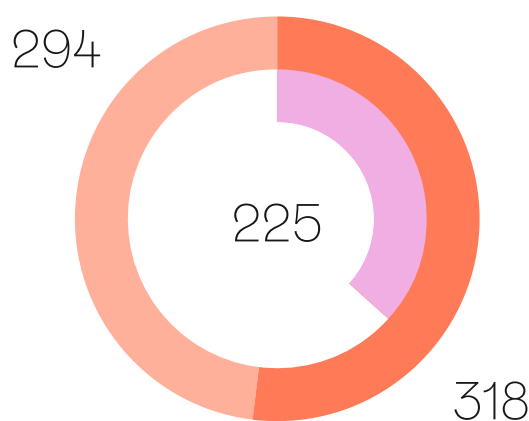

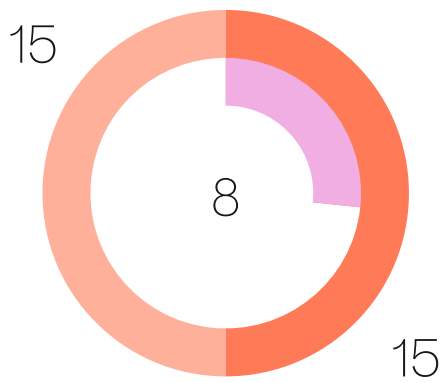

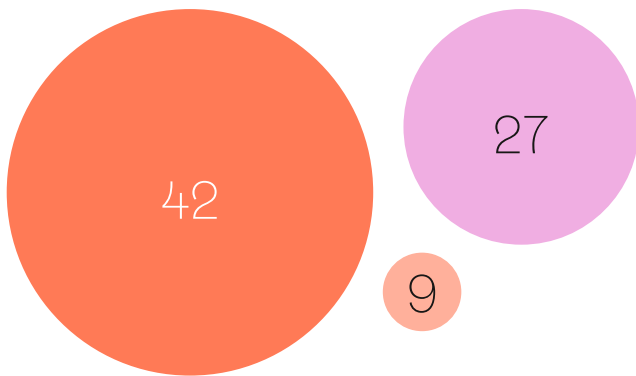
LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN COST ACTIONS



LEADERSHIP IN DETAIL

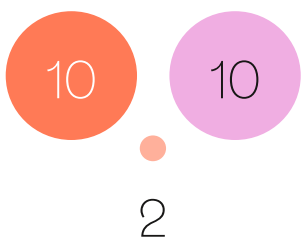
